The project 'GreenKeys – Urban Green as a Key for Sustainable Cities' focused on the improvement of urban green space systems as a step towards more sustainable cities by developing a 'Pool for Green Space Strategies'. The aim was to create and implement strategies for sustainable urban development based on urban green spaces adequate from social, ecological and economic perspectives.

Within three years (May 2005 to April 2008) 20 project partners (12 cities and 8 supporting institutions) from Bulgaria, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Italy, Poland and Slovenia had closely worked together.

All partner cities implemented pilot projects. Green spaces had been developed or enhanced with special attention to social, ecological and economical requirements. Additionally the cities started a process of formulating their own 'Urban Green Spaces Strategy' as a collective vision for the development of green spaces meeting community needs.

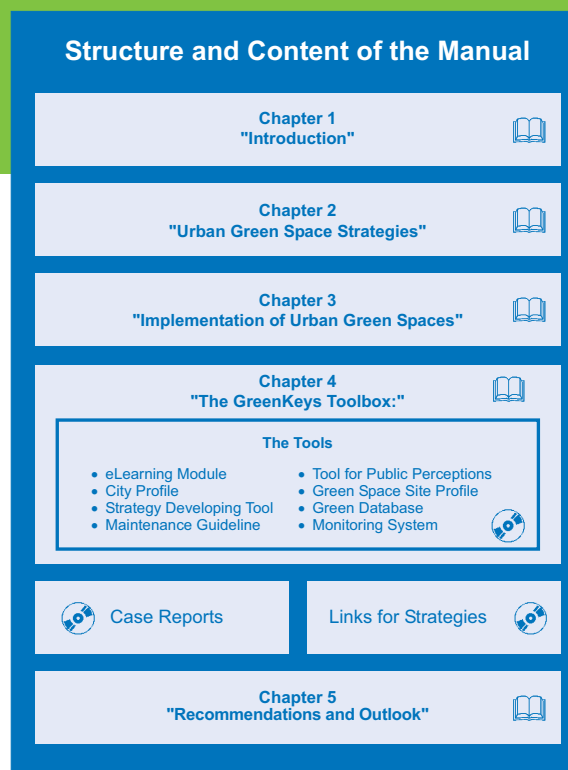

## A Guide for Urban Green Quality

- The manual 'GreenKeys @ Your City – A Guide for Urban Green Quality' is one of the major outcomes of the GreenKeys Project. It contains suggestions for green spaces development in European cities and provides guidance on the preparation and implementation of an urban green space strategy.
- The manual is a synthesis of the expertise and experiences gained by the GreenKeys partners during the course of the project.
- It is orientated towards problem solving and contains tools, methodology, a catalogue of case studies and good practice examples. A 'Pool for Green Space Strategies' had been established, which is now available.
- The manual seeks to raise awareness about the specific problems of urban green development and the kinds of solutions which might be applied. Many of the problems are commonplace across the European Union and beyond. In light of this the solutions have a transnational application.
- Recommendations have been included for a European green policy in order to develop community strategies, instruments and standards and to provide adequate funding for more liveable urban development.
